Cost

All fees for 3 or 4 day registrants include one t-shirt per paid registration and a Century of Flight Ride Award, should you choose to accept the challenge. You are welcome to register for one day or all four. Non-rider fees include ONLY tent camping and evening activities provided by GTCC. Shirts can be purchased for \$15.00 each on-site. Children ages 2-4 are free (no t-shirts).

There will be an additional \$10 fee for registrations postmarked after July 1, 2008.

Important to Note

- Registration includes tent camping, SAG, fully-supported rest stops, purchase pick-up, use of on-site swimming pool and all activities and amenities provided by GTCC.
- Separate arrangements must be made for other lodging/RV camping.
- Fees do not include meals.
- Youth under age 18 must be accompanied by a responsible adult at all times.
- Non-riders may only attend if accompanying paid adult riders.
- On-site shirt availability not guaranteed for registrations received after July 1, 2008.
- \$25 processing fee charged for refunds prior to July 1, 2008; no refunds after July 1.
- No alcohol permitted on the trails or at the campgrounds.
- \$30 fee charged for returned checks.

THE 'CLASSIC' EXPERIENCE

Greene Trails Cycling Classic is a fun, family-oriented get-away. Centered in Greene County, it is a multi-day bicycle tour designed to showcase the nationally recognized and award-winning rail-to-trail system, along with the varied communities along those trails.



All rides begin and end at the event campgrounds located at Greene County Parks' Fairgrounds Recreation Center, with each day featuring and utilizing a different trail. Specific routes are supported for rider convenience and safety, including package pick-up for shoppers. Routes will include on-trail, out-and-back trips, as well as extended rides on rural routes for designated days.

The broad network of trails provides an exceptional cycling experience for families or individuals along the safety and comfort of the trails, while alternate routes offer a choice for the more adventurous. Each day will offer special aviation-themed entertainment opportunities and unique things to see and do along the way.

DESIGN-A-RIDE

One of the best things about this event is that if you can't be here all 4 days, you can Design-A-Ride that fits your family's busy lifestyle and schedule. Fees are available for 1, 2, 3 or all 4 days and include a tent campsite, use of the county's pool, bathing facilities, ride support, and evening entertainment for the number of nights registered.



THURSDAY, JULY 17

Take off on your exciting aviation-themed adventure with a morning Welcome Ceremony and a Blessing of the Bikes. Then you're off on your first excursion along the Ohio To Erie Trail through the quaint Village of Jamestown passing by rural country farmlands to the Fayette County line for a total of 33 miles. As alternate options, continue on to South Charleston and London (62 miles) or take an off-trail tour of Greene County's covered bridges for an additional 8 miles.

The evening's entertainment will feature an historical aviation attraction with lots of fun surprises. Meal tickets MUST be purchased in advance. More information will be announced once details are finalized. Check the website for more information.



FRIDAY, JULY 18

Your flight plan today offers the annual Century Ride down to Loveland and back for a total of 100 miles along the shady Little Miami Scenic Trail. Not up for the total 100? Turn back at any time for less miles! Awards will be given to those who complete The Century Ride.
