All of the internships with Greene County Parks are non-paid positions however, housing is available. A minimum of 15 but no more than 40 hours per week is required. Hours are flexible and will include some evenings and weekends. Submit your resume to the contact information below.

Naturalist Internship

Responsibilities include:

- Assist with development, preparation and presentation of nature programs for the general public and school groups
- Assist with natural history collections including live animals, teaching materials and exhibits
- Assist with planning and coordination of events
- School and public outreach and data collection

Requirements include:

- Currently enrolled in one or more of the following: natural sciences, interpretation, biology or education
- Must possess a strong interest and enthusiasm about the environment and a desire to share that appreciation of nature with children and the public.
- Must have good communication, interpersonal and presentation skills
- Must be a team player with creativity, imagination and energy
- Willingness to help with a variety of different tasks and projects.

- Peak hours: mornings, evenings, weekends and holidays
