Buckeye Trail Re-Route:

Mr. Frazier mentioned a proposal from a Buckeye Trail representative to reroute the Buckeye Trail to avoid a section of the trail coming from Enon into Fairborn that follows some dangerous roads. They would reroute through Twin Towers Park and Pearl's Fen. The board agreed that this would be beneficial to trail users.

Agraria - Grant Request:

Mr. Frazier discussed a grant request from Agraria in Yellow Springs for \$48,000 to finish a project they started last year that the board already granted \$30,000 for.

Bike Trail - Request for Business Signage:

Mr. Frazier received a letter requesting signage on the bike trail advertising their business. The board decided they will research other areas and revisit at a later time.

Staffing Changes:

Mr. Frazier discussed some staffing changes including filling the fiscal position, as well as a new maintenance position being filled in the next week. Intermittent campground interviews are underway and the addition of an intermittent ranger position has been agreed upon. Some intermittents have left for the year as well.

Fair:

The department has a booth for the week of the Greene County Fair and staff will be out each day to talk with people about the parks and events going on during the rest of the year.

Projects:

Mr. Inman updated the board on the current special projects within the park system.

1. <u>Xenia-Jamestown Connector</u>: The berm work is completed. Striping and intersection ADA ramps are the remaining items.

- 2. <u>Narrows Building</u>: The walk way replacement is completed. We are working on the painting, flooring and lighting. Meeting with contractor on landscape / brush removal.
- 3. <u>Entrance Signs</u>: All signs have been installed. The Glenn Thompson sign will not be installed until the ODOT Road project and the park has been restored.
